I'm following up on my inquiry of January 8.

I would really appreciate if you would reply and let me know if the order for a hydraulic chute for Flying "L" Ranch in British Columbia, has been cancelled or remains active. I am not requesting any other details beyond that.

The reason is that by his own accounting in his social media posts Mr. Lares has raised, through a year-long donation campaign, more than US\$22K specifically for the purchase of a hydraulic horse chute from you. His social media posts include pictures and videos of your business and horse chutes. Still, as of today there are no indications the chute ordered from you is on Lares' ranch, or in transit. Mr. Lares is silent on the the use of the donations received, leaving donors in the dark.

If the order has been cancelled, then a host of concerns arise (**none of which have anything to do with you or your business**).

Is the order remains active then that at least provides a measure of comfort to donors.
